ORDER

Where District Court Judge Shelley M. Joseph has been indicted by a Federal grand jury

on charges of obstruction of justice relating to alleged misconduct in her judicial office, the

Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court, in the exercise of their powers of general superintendence

of the courts of the Commonwealth, hereby suspend her without pay from her duties as an

associate Justice of the District Court until further order of this court.

This Order is based solely on the fact that a sitting judge has been indicted for alleged

misconduct in the performance of her judicial duties. It in no way reflects any opinion on the

merits of the pending criminal case. The Code of Judicial Conduct prohibits all judges from

making "any statement that might reasonably be expected to affect the outcome or impair the

fairness of a matter pending or impending in any Massachusetts court." SJC Rule 3:09, Code of

Judicial Conduct, Rule 2.10.

This suspension is effective immediately.
